## Why we want to build sustainable companies



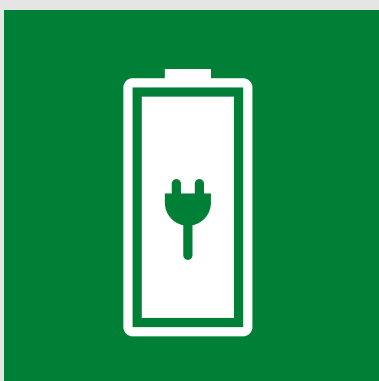
### 1 Environmental Policy
